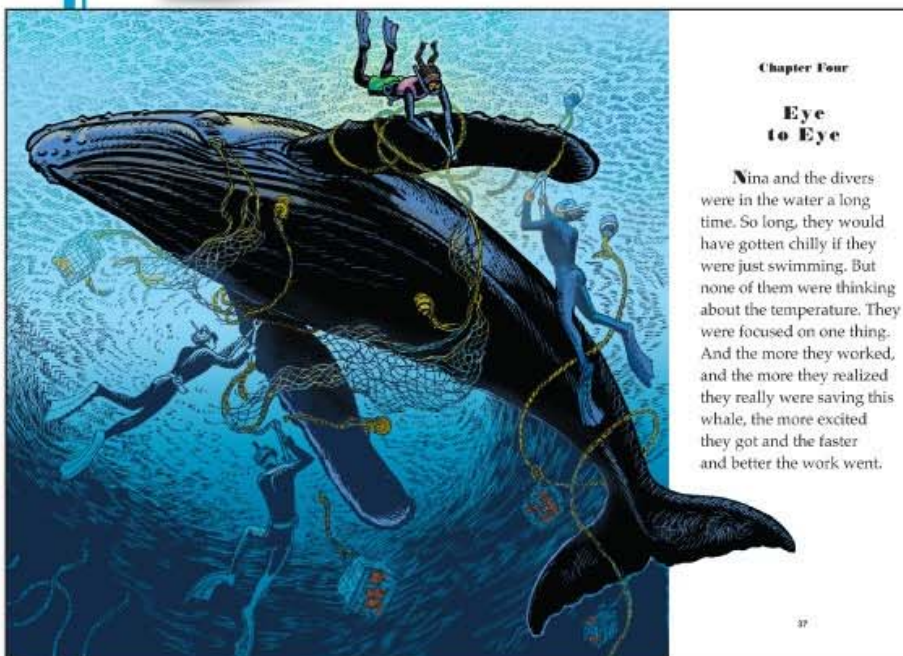
Carl Safina's work has been profiled in the *New York Times*, on Nightline, and in the Bill Moyers TV special "Earth on Edge." Safina is a recipient of the Pew Scholar's Award in Conservation and the Environment, a World Wildlife Fund Senior Fellowship, the Lannan Literary Award for nonfiction, the John Burroughs Medal for literature, and a MacArthur Prize. Safina's scientific prowess, sense of adventure, and elegant descriptions of the mystery, magnificence, and importance of the sea and its creatures make him one of today's most important voices in conservation.

Carl's first book, *Song for the Blue Ocean*, was chosen as a *New York Times* Notable Book of the Year, a *Los Angeles Times* Best Nonfiction, a *Library Journal* Best Science Book selection; and Amazon.com's best-selling "science and nature" book. He is also the author of *Eye of the Albatross*, *Voyage of the Turtle*, and *The View from Lazy Point*.
